In every Newton County Saddle Club class, except for Championship Classes, we award a Champion, Reserve Champion, and high point ribbons - 3rd through 10th in Challenged Rider, Beginner, Advanced Beginner and LTD classes and 3rd through 6th in all other classes. Our high point program allows more exhibitors to be rewarded for their season of hard work than most saddle clubs. We do not break ties - all winners are awarded. Traditionally, we have our exhibitors choose their award(s) from a provided list rather than automatically awarding trophies or plaques.

Ribbon placings will not appear on this letter, only Championships and Reserve Championships. Points are on the website to check for other placings. Ribbon Placings will also be awarded at the End of Year Banquet.

EXCEPT FOR LEADLINE CLASSES WHICH WILL RECEIVE TROPHIES, you will be given \$30 for each Championship and \$20 for each Reserve Championship. Choose your awards based on the \$ amount you have won (above), you can request a check for that amount, or a combination of the two. If you are close to having enough money to combine your classes to get a more expensive item you can send a check to cover up to \$20 over the amount you have won. This money has to be included with your order or the item will not be ordered for you. **We cannot wait and get the money from you at the banquet. Find award choices and order forms on the website in PDF form. Email them to Kathy Johnson or print them out and mail them.**

Be sure to **PRINT your name and your horse's name CLEARLY on the order forms** - we may have been misspelling your name or your horse's name all season long. **We are not responsible for misspelled items without this information!**

You must call, email or mail your order in by December 7th, 2018. There will be no exceptions to this deadline date. Many awards manufacturers shut down in December for a week or two so giving them enough lead time is important. If we do not receive your information by the above date, you will be awarded a check for any money you have won. If you wish to receive a check for your awards, please let us know so that we know you received your letter. Whitehorse Manufacturing, one of our long-time vendors, is closed indefinitely due to illness so please hold them in your thoughts and prayers. We will miss their beautifully made award items.

Congratulations on your 2018 Season! We look forward to celebrating a great year with you at the Awards Banquet on Sunday, January 13th at the GA FFA-FCCLA Center. **There will be an invitation for the banquet on the website as soon as we have all information** . Be sure to pay attention to reservation/payment deadlines - these are final as we have to provide head counts to the banquet facility by a certain date.
